2	Count, read and write numbers to 100 in numerals	
3	Read and write mathematical symbols, such as + (addition), - (subtraction) and = (equals)	
4	Identify 'one more' and 'one less' from any number up to 100	
5	Use number bonds and subtraction facts up to 20	
6	Add and subtract 1-digit and 2-digit numbers up to 20, including 0	
7	Recognise, find and name a half (1/2) of shapes, objects and numbers up to 20	
8	Recognise, find and name a quarter (1/4) of shapes, objects and numbers up to 20	
9	Measure and begin to record length and height, mass, capacity and time	
10	Recognise and know the value of all coins and notes	
11	Use language to sequence events in chronological order (time order)	
12	Recognise and use the language for dates, such as days, weeks, months and years and to know the days of the week	
13	Tell the time to the half-hour and o'clock, including drawing clocks	
14	Recognise and name common 2-D shapes, such as square, rectangle, triangle and circle	
15	Recognise and name common 3-D shapes, such as cube, cuboid, pyramid and sphere
