School Improvement Plan (SIP) Priorities 2018/19

Each academic year, the school is required to write a School Improvement Plan (SIP). This is a document which shows the key areas of focus that the school needs to prioritise improving and shapes school leaders' thoughts and decisions about the direction of the school.

In 2018/19, the school has collected information to identify **five** key priorities to further improve the school. These are:

1) To raise standards in Reading

- To refine the use of the Primary Writing Project with a particular focus on using it as a vehicle to improve pupils' reading.
- To improve the quality of teaching of phonics.
- To develop the use of Accelerated Reader.

2) To further embed the Talk for Writing Approach

- To develop the use of the Primary Writing Project.

3) To further develop the curriculum

- To further develop the curriculum so that there is clear intent to each unit of work, the implementation is effective and the impact can be evaluated.

4) To refine assessment procedures

- To develop the assessment policy so that the purpose is clear, that data collected is valid, reliable and valuable (components of effective assessment).

5) To further develop provision for vulnerable pupils and their families

- To further develop the Nurture provision.
- To ensure that Early Help resources are used effectively.
