Sport Premium Money at King Offa Primary Academy

King Offa Primary Academy has been issued with £9000 from the Government as part of the Sport Premium initiative. This sum of money is ring fenced and is to be spent by the school on 'improving the quality of sport and PE'. OFSTED will be focusing on how effectively this premium is used towards the given objective and as a school we are held to account about how we have spent this money.

At King Offa Primary Academy the Head teacher, senior team and PE Leader have given careful consideration to how this money should be spent and our rationale for spending the money is;

- To improve the quality of the sport and PE that we are already offering to the children; ensuring all children benefit
- Offer training opportunities to staff to improve teaching and learning and for CPD
- Ensure the school is able to participate in local tournaments and festivals
- Encourage more participation in a wider range of after school activities for all children; including FSM
- Develop intra school competitions

As a result we are very pleased to explain how the Sports Premium will be spent during the academic year 2014-2015.

- Employment of a specialist level 2 (or above) sports coach from Premier Sport to assist teachers in the delivery of teaching high quality PE to Foundation Stage, KS1 and KS2 children
- Use of Premier Sport to establish and instigate local Inter school sports competitions and festivals
- For every child to receive swimming lessons at school during the academic year
- Support FSM in any paid clubs offered throughout the year
- Employment of coaches to deliver after school clubs throughout the whole year
- Support for the PE co-ordinator to assist the school in improving teaching and assessment of PE
- Increase variety and quality of equipment in the hall and playground
